OTHER NATIONS (INCLUDING JAPAN AND GERMANY) WERE ALSO DEVELOPING ATOMIC BOMBS IN THE FIRST HALF OF THE 1940S, ALBEIT HAPHAZARDLY. INDEED, IT IS DIFFICULT TO IMAGINE ANY COMBATANT NATION FOREGOING THE USE OF THE BOMB DURING THE WAR HAD IT BEEN ABLE TO OBTAIN ONE. THE INTERNATIONAL TEAM OF SCIENTISTS ORGANIZED BY THE AMERICANS JUST GOT THERE FIRST. AS THIS FASCINATING NEW HISTORY SHOWS, THE BOMB DROPPED BY A US PILOT THAT HOT AUGUST MORNING IN 1945 WAS IN MANY WAYS THE WORLD'S OFFSPRING, IN BOTH A TECHNOLOGICAL AND A MORAL SENSE.
